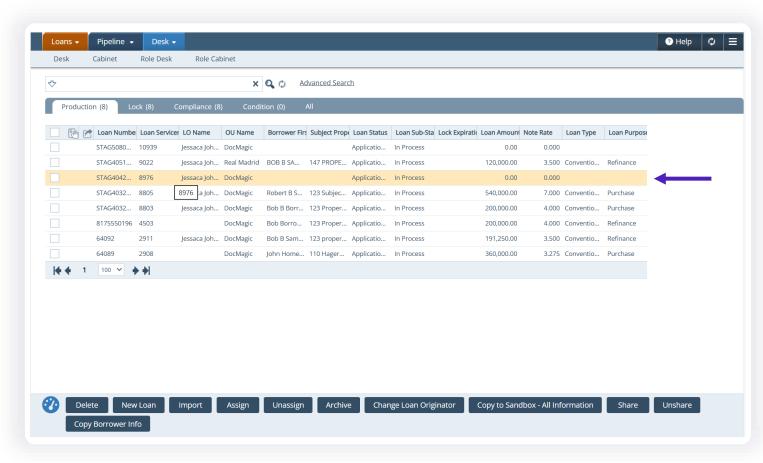

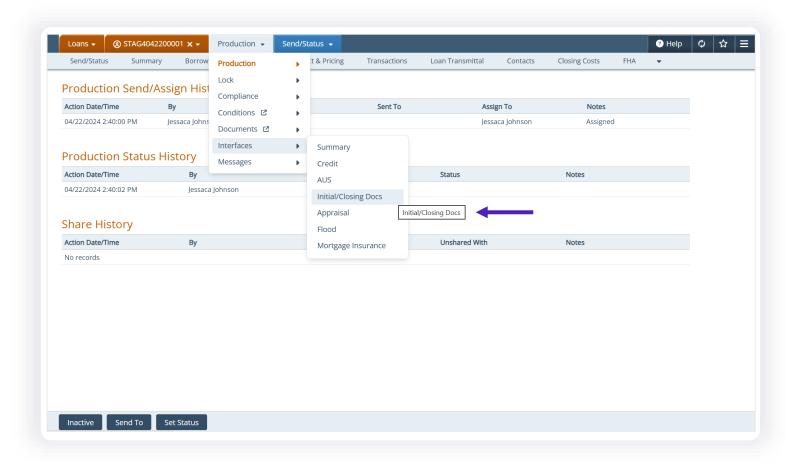

## File Selection



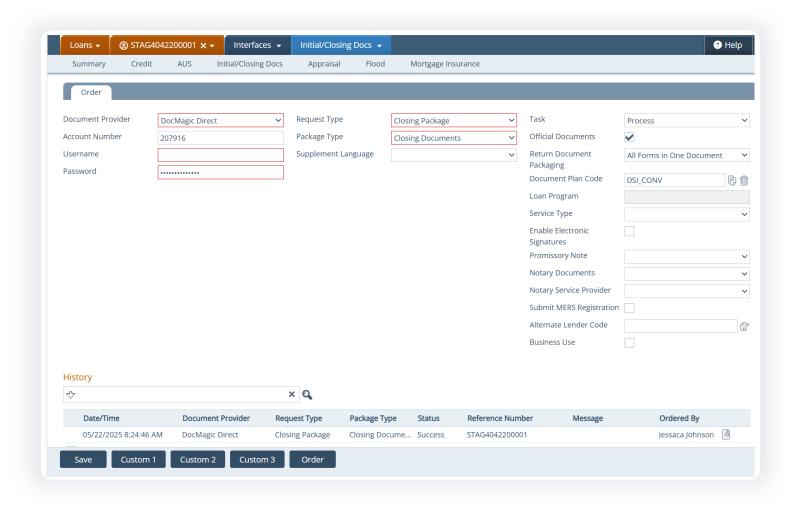
Select a file from your CalyxPath pipeline.

# Production → Interfaces → Initial/Closing Docs



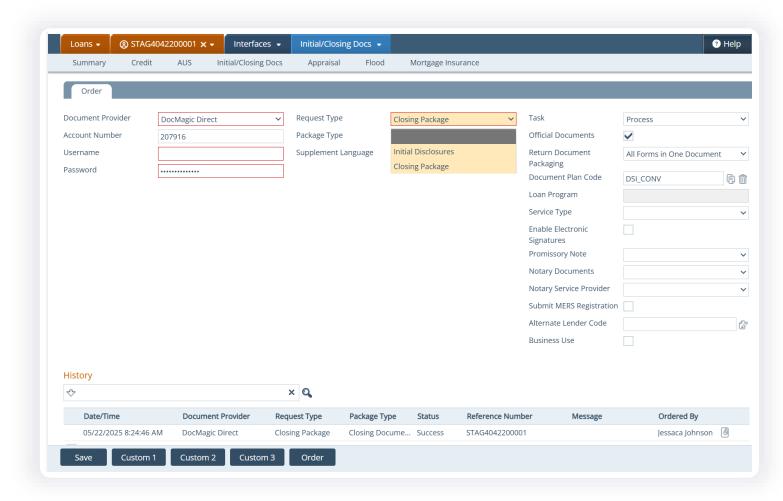
 Hover your mouse over *Production* at the top, then *Interfaces*, and then click on *Initial/Closing Docs*.

#### **Order Docs Screen**



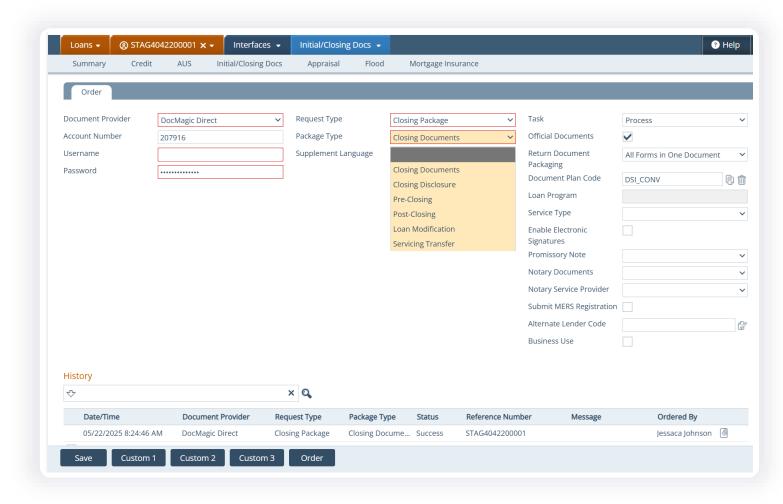
- Start on the left side of the screen.

# **Request Type**



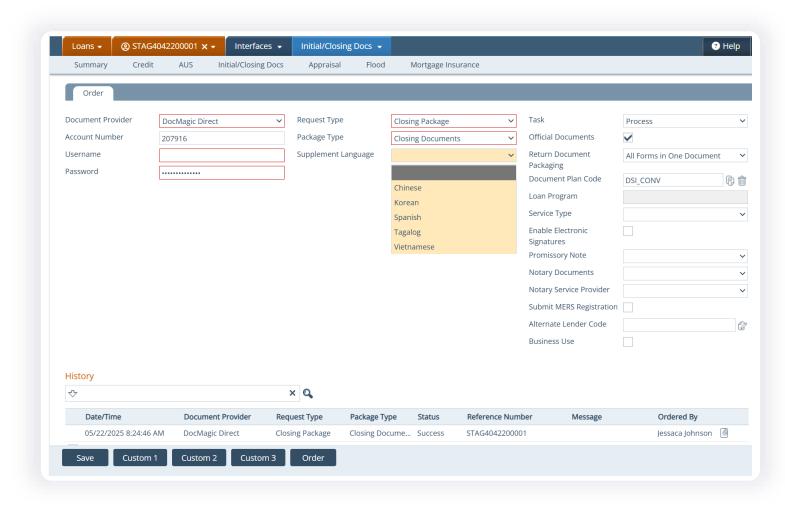
 Select Initial Disclosure or Closing Package from the Request Type.

# Package Type



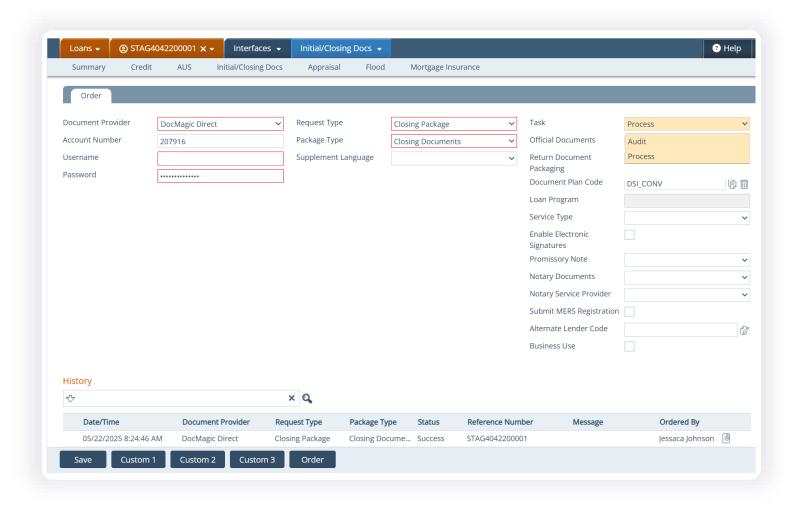
- Next, select a Package Type.

## Supplement Language



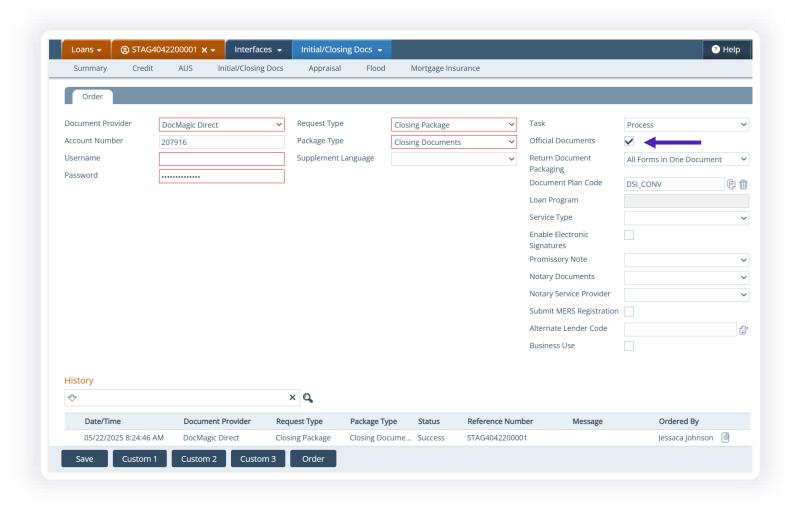
- DocMagic does support supplementary languages in some cases.

## **Select Task**



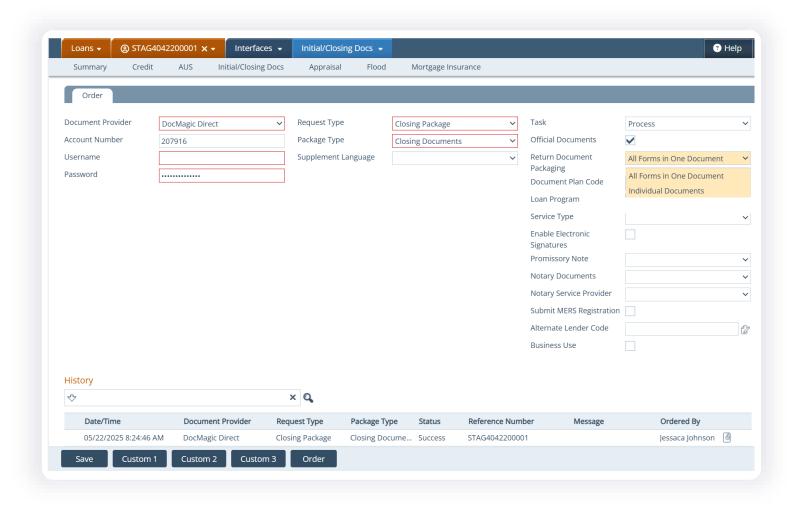
- Select Audit or Process for the Task.
  - Our DocMagic Audit checks for any issues related to data entry or compliance and generates a full <u>Loan Detail Report</u>.
  - Process orders a set of documents.

#### Official Documents



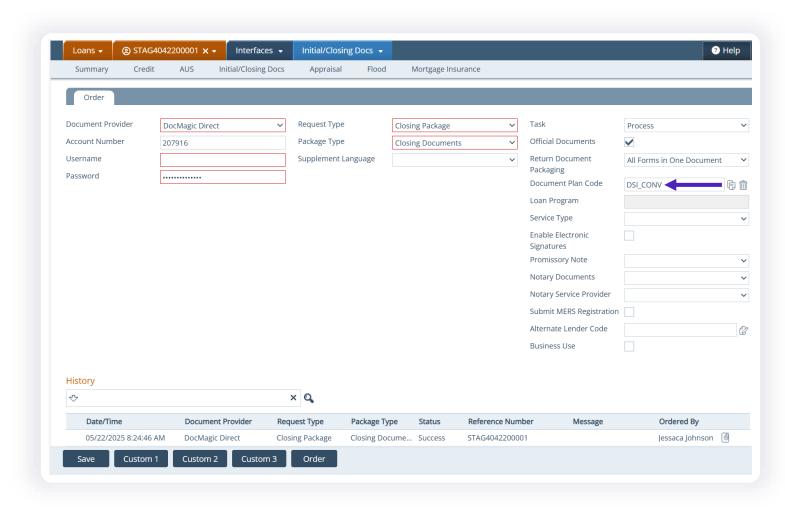
 Unchecking the Official Documents box will produce a document package with a watermark. This is mostly used for running sample packages. Please note that DocMagic will not keep the data if this box is unchecked.

# **Return Document Packaging**



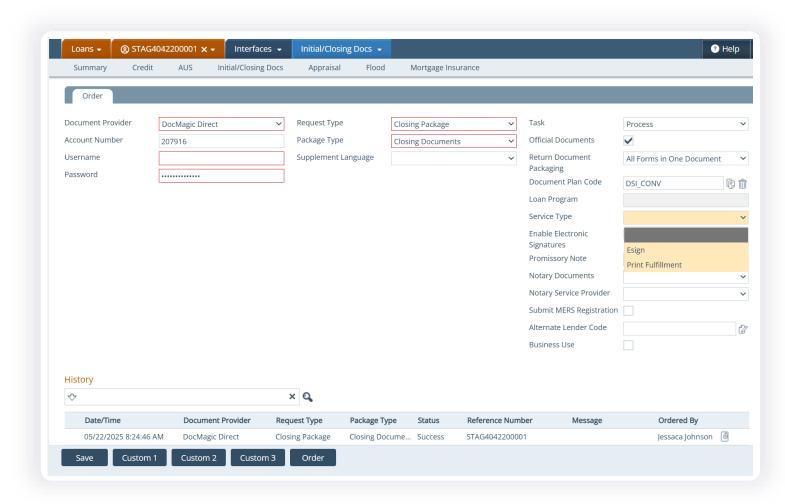
 You can choose to receive the document package as Individual Documents or generate All Forms in One Document.

#### **Document Plan Code**



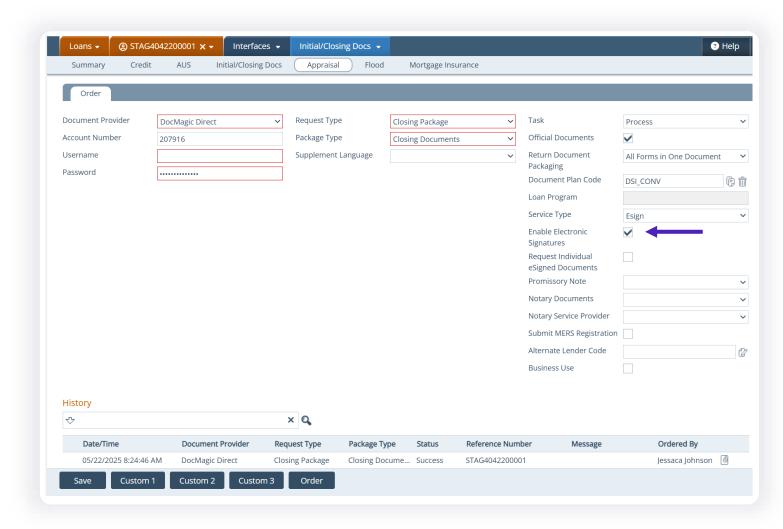
- Enter your Document Plan Code. These will need to be added to your Account through the <u>Plan Manager</u> on the DocMagic Dashboard.

## Select Service Type



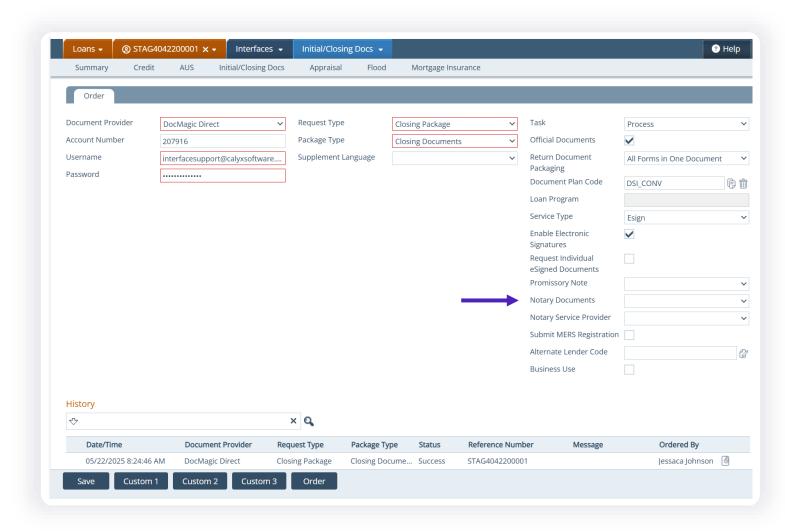
- Select Esign or Print Fufillment for Service Type.
  - Esign utilizes our proprietary ClickSign electronic signature technology. Packages generated with this option can be managed in the esign Console.
  - Select Print Fulfillment if you want the document package to be printed and mailed out.

## **Enable Electronic Signatures**



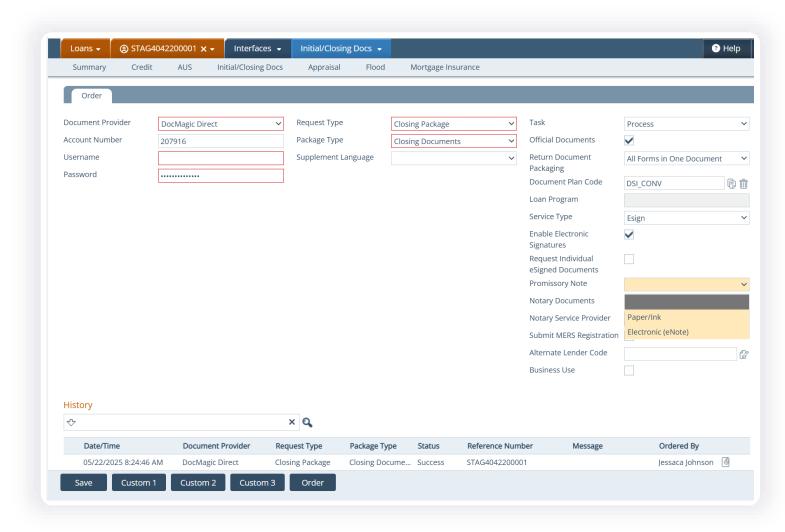
- You'll need to check the Enable Electronic Signatures box if you select Esign as your Service Type.
- Once you check that box, the option for Requesting Individual eSigned Documents will appear.

## eClose Package Configuration



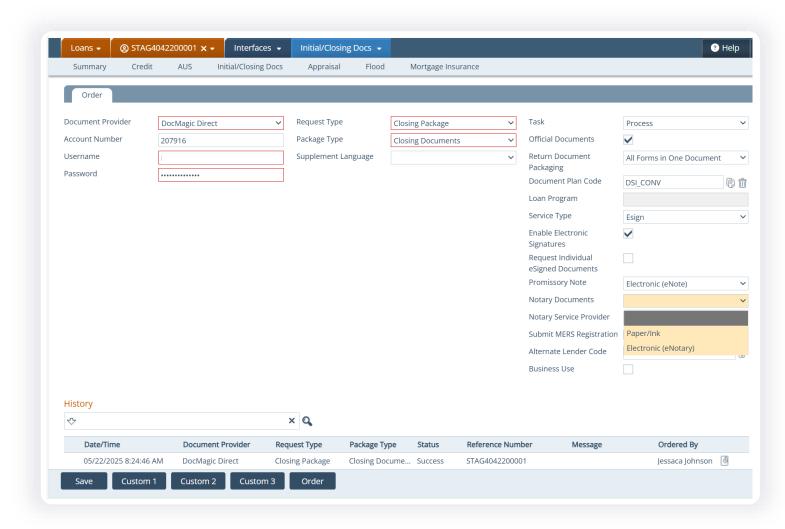
 If you are generating an eClose Closing Package, you will need to configure the Promissory Note, Notary Documents, and Notary Service Provider options, explained on subsequent pages.

## **Promissory Note**



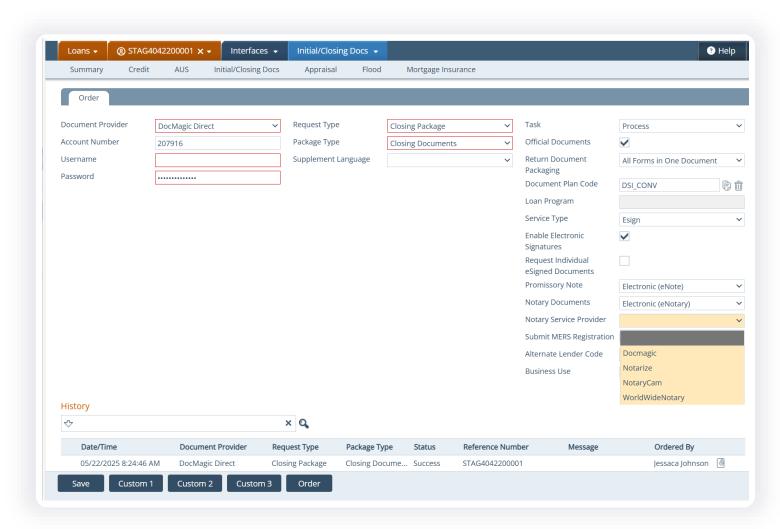
- Select if you want the Promissory Note to be Paper or Electronic (eNote).
- The blank, default option will result in a Paper Note being generated if a Closing Package is requested.

# **Notary Documents**



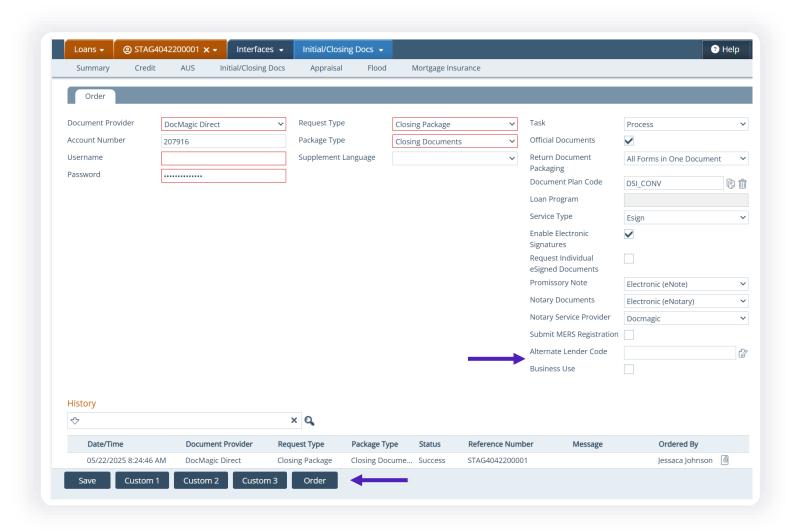
 Select if you want the Notarization portion of your Closing package to be paper or electronic.

# **Notary Service Provider**



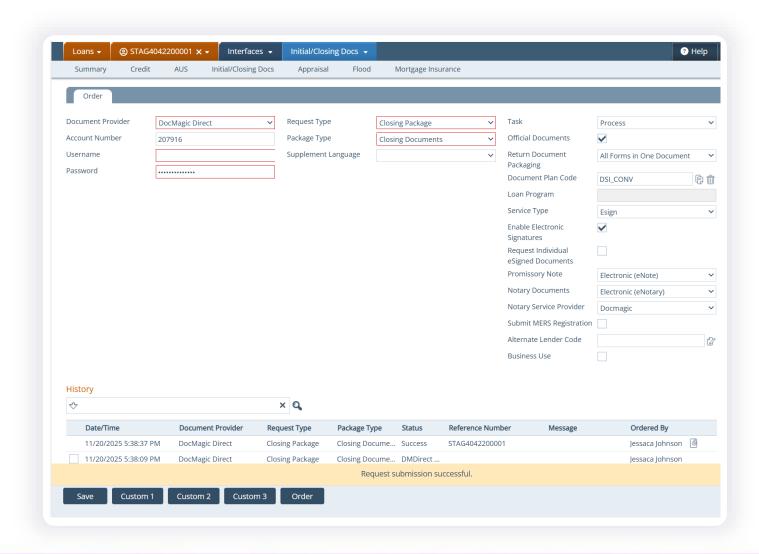
- Select your Notary Service Provider if you will be doing electronic notarization for a Closing Package.
- If you want to utilize our proprietary Remote Online Notary (RON) or In-Person Electronic Notarization (IPEN) technology, choose DocMagic for this option.

### **Order Docs**



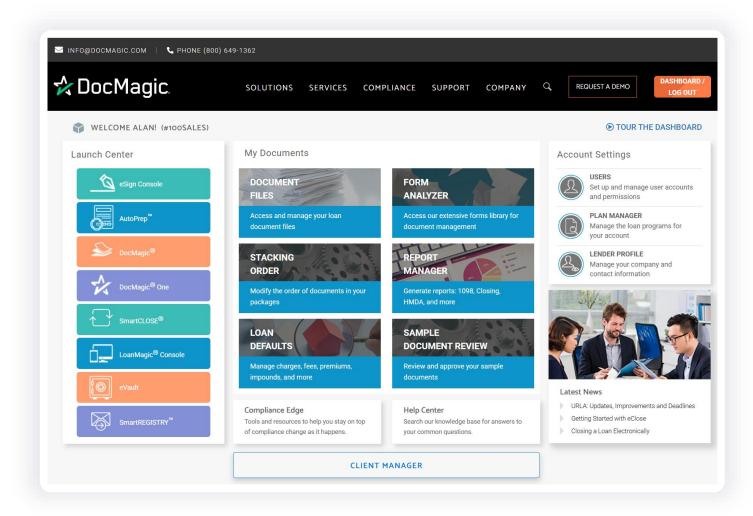
- Finally, you can enter an Alternate Lender Code here if you have one and check the box for Business Purpose Loan if applicable.
